

The Belize Fort Authority will grant an approval to construct an over water structure pursuant to the terms and conditions listed below:

- The Belize Port Authority must be informed before any structures are placed in the sea.
- A detailed plan showing construction and dimension of the proposed structure along with an formal application letter must be sent to the attention of the Ports Commissioner for approval.
- Input from the Belize City Council, Ministry of Natural Resources, and the Department of Environment.
- Day markers must be placed on the pier to reduce the risk of accidents.
- The proper installation of amber flashing lights with (2) miles visibility at the 25 ft, 50 ft and 100 ft points.
- A draft Notice to Mariners must be submitted to the Ports Commissioner for approval before being publicized.
- A notice to Mariners must be placed in all major newspapers for a period of two weeks before construction commences.
- Construction must remain within the final specification submitted and any alterations must be submitted to the Ports Commissioner for further written approval.
- Site visits will be conducted by the Belize Port Authority to ensure compliance with the specified conditions of the approval.

Please be reminded that the approval granted is contingent upon full compliance with the conditions listed above and any breech of the said conditions will result in the revocation of the approval. If revoked you will be required to remove the structure or the Belize Port Authority will remove it at the owner's expense.
